Effective October 6, 2020, all government entities and prospective bidders must use the new bidding documents for the procurement of goods and infrastructure. New documents, new rules!

These 3.5-hour online training programs aim to guide participants and enhance their skills in the preparation and use of the new Philippine Bidding Documents (6TH EDITION). Both programs are designed to help the procuring entities adequately prepare a set of bidding documents that will be responsive to the needs of the end users and to allow the prospective bidders prepare bids that will be responsive to all the requirements for the procurement thereby increasing their chances of winning the bid for government projects.

Failure to successfully conclude procurement projects are normally due to faulty crafting of the requirements in the bidding documents and the disqualification of bidders are attributable to inability to align their bidding documents to the procurement guidelines.
