The Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA 9514, or the Fire Code of the Philippines, serves as the framework that guides the BFP in the implementation of the law to ensure public safety and to promote economic development through the prevention and suppression of all kinds of destructive fires. To strengthen various provisions of the IRR due to the demand of technological changes in building designs and constructions, revisions were made effective October 16, 2019.

Attend this 2-session webinar to ensure compliance and avoid costly mistakes. The training will walk you through the IRR and its essential revisions based on the previous IRR so that each of the rules, divisions and sections of RA 9514 will have clarity to ensure adherence to the updated standards of fire prevention and safety measures, and promote utmost accountability.
